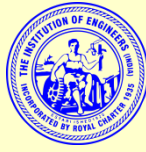

- Gardening for the aesthetic beatification of Durgapur Local Centre campus


## 7. Audited Accounts:

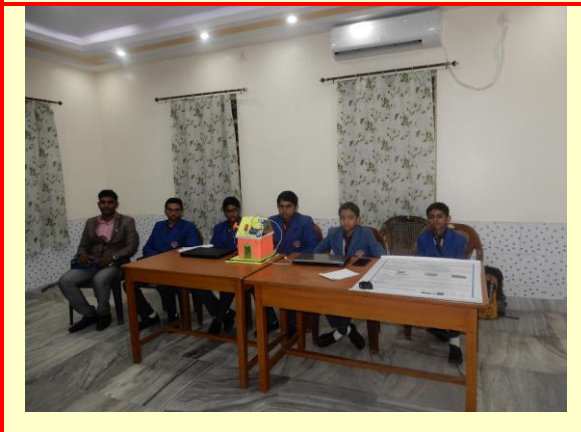
